FISCAL YEAR HIGHLIGHTS

It's been an exciting year for Dental Connections as we continue to increase our patient base to pre-COVID levels. Because of the pandemic, patients have not had regular dental visits and their oral health needs are greater than ever. To accommodate the increased need, the clinic implemented new policies and procedures to enable more efficient management of patient scheduling while maintaining high quality care.

Dental Connections fills a vital need in the community for children and families that face challenges in receiving oral health care. The vast majority of our patients rely on state insurance (Medicaid) to pay their health expenses; however, very few dental practices accept Medicaid. Dental Connections becomes one of few sources for quality dental care.



SMILE SQUAD MOBILE DENTAL CLINIC

The Smile Squad mobile dentistry program plays an important role in serving students in the Greater Des Moines area. The Smile Squad visits 58 schools in 8 districts, providing vital oral health care to underserved children who might not otherwise see a dentist on a regular basis. In collaboration with school nurses who identify students in need of services, the Smile Squad eliminates barriers in accessing care. In addition to comprehensive care on the mobile dental units, the Smile Squad also provides screenings and fluoride treatments to preschoolers, third and eighth grade students.

During the summer months, the mobile dental clinics don't sit idly! Through community partnerships we provide critical outreach and care to the following organizations:

- Iowa Homeless Youth Shelter
- House of Mercy
- Prairie Meadows Racetrack seasonal workers through the Iowa Horseman's Benevolent & Protective Association

"We have so many children that do not have dental insurance and parents can't afford the dentist. Some parents aren't able to take off work to bring them to the dentist or don't have cars to drive to dental appointments.

Many of our students have horrible dental problems. They come to my office complaining of teeth hurting. Yes, teeth: it is never just one tooth. I look in their mouths and see parts of teeth missing or blackened teeth from decay. When they are in so much pain they are unable to focus on school work. They miss days of school because their teeth hurt. Some students have never been to a dentist.

The Smile Squad helps our students feel better and look better. Without them, this would not be possible."

MOBILE DENTAL CLINIC CAMPAIGN

In January 2023, Dental Connections started a campaign to replace one of our aging mobile dental units, which are 15 and 20 years old. Six months into the campaign, over half of the funds have been raised and we have been able to order the unit. Having a new mobile dental unit will allow us to retire one of the original units and allow us to expand our outreach to additional schools and human services organizations in the Des Moines area and beyond.
